ANNUAL FISHING TOURNAMENT 2011

RULES AND REGS

TOURNAMENT DATES & LOCATION

The tournament will take place on May 31, 2011 at Stiltsville (Miami Springs Power Boat Club), followed by weigh in and dock party. Captains meeting to be held on May 30, 2011 at 7:00 P.M. in the Benevolent Hall.

REGISTRATION AND FEES

Entry fee is \$40.00 per angler and must be received on May 27th, 2011. Each boat must have a City of Miami Fire Rescue Member on-board. Each entry will receive a tournament shirt. Each boat will also receive a goodie bag and other sponsor provided promotional items for each angler.

FISHING RULES

Rod & Reel only. Have fun.

REFUNDS

No refunds will be given for any reason including, but not limited to acts of nature, war, national security.

LICENSES AND PERMITS

All participating anglers must possess necessary licenses and permits including, but not limited to the Florida Saltwater Fishing License.

ELIGIBLE SPECIES

Dolphin - *Caryphalna Hippurus*

COMMUNICATIONS

All participating boats should monitor VHF channel #68.

FISHING TIMES

The official start time is 07:00 May 31st, 2011. This will be marked by an official announcement of "lines-in". The official end time is 16:00 at the dock. Fish will not be weighed after 16:00.

OVERALL TOURNAMENT

Prizes awarded as follows:
1st Prize- \$1,500 (the Heaviest Dolphin)
2nd Prize- \$ 600 (2nd Heaviest Dolphin)
3rd Prize- \$ 400 (3 Heaviest Combined)
Ties will be broken according to earliest weigh-in time.

WEATHER CONDITIONS

In the event of unsafe weather conditions, the tournament organizers may choose to postpone the event.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY

It is expressly understood that all participants in the Tournament enter at their own risk and that all persons connected directly or indirectly with the operations of the tournament, or any sponsor of the tournament shall be exempt from any liability for slander, loss, damage, harm, negligence, injury or death suffered by any participant, anglers or their companions, boat captains, mates, crew members, guest, entrant, vessels and equipment which may occur during the tournament.
